Congratulations to Danica Roberts for her performance at the SSAA Combined Services Discipline State Championships for Pistols, held on Friday August 27th at Windamere Shooting Complex. Danica won three Gold Medals for - 1st in 3P Core Event Class 1 with a score of 194.6, 1st in 3P Core Event Class 2 with a score of 244 and 1st in Top Junior Class 1 Events 1-4 with a total of 331.6

Danica also won two Silver Medals for 2nd in 50 metre, Long Range Pistol, Open, Class 1 or 2, class 2, Junior, her first shoot at this distance. Also for 2nd in Standing Rapid Fire 25 metres Open, Class 2 Junior, only just beaten on a count back.
