The NSW Minerals Council (NSWMC) invites eligible upcoming Year 11 and 12 students to apply for a 2012 Minerals Educations Bursary (MEBS). This exciting initiative is due to be bigger than ever before with more sponsoring companies and available bursaries. ANGLICARE Western NSW - No Interest Loan Scheme

Anglicare is offering a No Interest Loan Scheme here in Mudgee (NILS) which is an alternate form of credit, not emergency relief, with no fees or charges. The aim is to provide low income earners the means to purchase essential household items. Loans are provided to people who have the ability to repay the loan in small fortnightly repayments.

You are eligible to access a loan from us if you live in the Mid Western Regional Council area and are on a Centrelink benefit or are a low income earner. The money can be used to purchase things like electrical goods, furniture, baby items, medical equipment, mobility aids or something else that will improve the quality of life for you. It cannot be used for living expenses, rent and bond money or debt repayment.

If you are interested please phone 1800 644 556 (Anglicare Western, Dubbo) to check your eligibility and receive the information pack. If you wish to proceed with your application it will then be dealt with locally.
