This art exhibition showcases work from all Secondary and Primary schools in the Cudgegong Learning Community. The students were involved in the mise en place, preparation, presentation and service of the appetising canapés that were served on the night. The food was openly admired and enjoyed by the large crowd who attended the opening of the exhibition.

Year 12 Hospitality Excursion

Year 12 Hospitality will be travelling to Sydney during the last two days of Term 2, to extend their knowledge of the hospitality industry and inevitably they will be extending their waistline too. Some of the places they will visit include, the Carrington Hotel at Katoomba, often described as a "unique heritage property, steeped in history and the elegance of a bygone era". From there students will motor to The Italian Forum at Leichhardt. This contemporary French inspired patisserie showcases some of the most luscious, inventive cakes this side of the equator. The evening meal is a dining experience at a Korean BBQ.

The following day they will visit the Good Food and Wine Show at Darling Harbour, where they will be able to: discover a world of tastes, flavours, products and techniques, watch live demonstrations from celebrity chefs, try hands-on activities and sample an indulgent array of products. The celebrity chefs students have decided to enjoy are Gary Mehigan & George Calombaris - from MasterChef.

Over the weekend of Friday 20th to Sunday 22nd, the SSAA Mudgee & District Branch hosted the 2011 Single Action Revolver State Championships at the Windamere Regional Shooting Complex where, on her 15th birthday Danica took out the Top Junior Gold Medal and also came 3rd in the Rimfire class, just nipping at the heels of her mother.

The following Friday, May 27th Danica competed in the 2011 Combined Services Discipline State Championships Pistol events also at Windamere where her excellent performance earned her Junior Top Gun for both Class 1 and Class 2 Pistols, as well as 1st Junior for both Class 1 and 2 in 50 meter Long Range, 25 meter 3 Position, 25 meter Rapid Fire and the 3 Position Core Match over distances of 25, 15 and 7 meters. She also scored Bronze medals in the 3 Position Core Match for both Class 1 and 2 in C Grade.
