Principal's Message

On Wednesday 4 September 2013 Mudgee High School's Anti Bullying Team invited everyone who wanted to stick their neck out against bullying to wear a tie. There were prizes for students and staff who participated. The day produced some fun and interesting comments with staff and students finding novel ways to wear their ties and some gaudy outrageous offerings. The serious side of the day was to raise awareness among students and staff about the impacts of cyber bullying and how they might help the victims.

The highlight of the day was a presentation on assembly led by Jess Hardy and Taylor – Rose Rohrich on the impact cyber bullying and other types of bullying might have on the victim. Students were shown a video from the Human Rights Commission on ways they can say goodbye to cyber bullying. In the Human Rights Commission Back Me Up Campaign students are invited to find ways to show they don't agree with bullying by creating a 2 minute video about how they would back up someone being cyber bullied. The opportunity to win great prizes sparked a lot of interest among students who are looking for ways to support the anti-bullying message.

Year 12 are continuing their phenomenal effort to raise funds for their nominated charities. Cake Day last Friday saw hundreds of cakes and slices sold to students and staff. It was a great team effort from students and families baking up a storm all week. More were sold at the very successful garage sale on Saturday. I hope you took some home or bought some of the many other items on sale on Saturday. This week we will have milk shake day on Thursday where students can try some of the many flavours on offer.

Make Online Payments

From October 14 it will be possible for parents to make online payments to the school for amounts owing for students, via a secure payment page hosted by Westpac. Payments can be made using either a Visa or MasterCard credit or debit card. The payment page is accessed from the front page of the schools website by selecting \$ Make a payment

Items that can be paid include voluntary school contributions, subject contributions, excursions, sales to students and creative and practical arts activities (these include technology and visual arts major works). There is also a category called Other which is to cover items not covered in the previous headings, Other can be used to make a complete payment of a school invoice.

When you access the \$ Make a payment you must enter:

- the students name, and
- · class and reference number OR
- the students name, and
- date of birth.

These details are entered each time you make a payment as student information is not held within the payment system. There is also the option to enter the Student Registration Number and Invoice number if you are aware of them, these are optional fields.

This is a secure payment system hosted by Westpac to ensure that your credit/debit card details are captured in a secure manner, these details are not passed back to the school.

You have the ability to check and change any details of the payment before the payment is processed. Receipts can be emailed and/or printed.

Details of the payments are passed daily to the school where they will be receipted against your child's account. As a receipt has been issued from the payment page a further receipt will not be issued by the school.

Mudgee Cattle Update


The Mudgee Show team is busy preparing 3 steers for The Beef Bonanza in Scone. Once again, we have obtained 3 very high quality Angus steers form Coffin Creek stud. These animals have been the easiest to tame from the many we have shown and students are confident working close with them. They each weigh in the order of 500kg and to lead one of these beasts on the end of a short rope requires a lot of trust from both steer and handler.

Students in Year 11 Primary Industries and Ag20 have the preparation and showing as a special project. Washing, clipping and setting the feet for a good stance and is all part of the work. Preparing students for the show ring is another feature of their work. With the warmer weather here, the steers are losing their winter coat and require an extensive brushing every day with 'training' of the hair to run in a specific direction a high priority

The Cheetham family have been associated with our cattle showing since its inception. We have been grateful for the assistance offered by Geoff and Beth at previous shows and appreciate the offer of help in Scone this year. We also acknowledge their generous donation of hay and an offer of assistance in the transport of steers. With the high cost associated with these competitions, this assistance makes continued participation feasible.

We travel to Scone on October 24 with a group of 17 students and several staff. This is always a great weekend of learning and comradery and we are very positive about our prospects this year. Results will be published following the competition.

In additional to the expressions of thanks made above, in the past week RB irrigation provided a generous discount on goods purchased for the school farms and Steve Ledger of the Mudgee Veterinary Hospital donated his services for the Brucellosis testing of our rams. These very generous offers of support from the community are greatly appreciated and go a long way to the improvement of services to our students.
