Principal's Message

Rainbow Day DID go ahead on Wednesday 8 December.

Rainbow Day is in its 20th iteration this year, having begun in 2002, and is very much a Mudgee High cultural institution. This year's departing HSC class was able to run stalls and entertain Year 6 students from our primary partner schools – Cudgegong Valley PS and Mudgee PS – and later students from Mudgee High's Years 7 to 11. The weather

promised to put the RAIN back into rainbow, but alternative lodgings for the event were found beneath the covered areas comprising F Block and the Gymnasium.

The stalls were exceedingly popular. Year 12 raised over \$2800 for their charity; Mudgee hospital.

There may have been no roadside collections and a limited number of opportunities to get out there and do community good, but good Year 12 did do. The final figure will be announced next week.

CLAIM TWO Stoos voucehers
