# Construction

- Construction (240 indicative hours) 2 Preliminary and 2 HSC units in total.
- Board Developed Course Category B status for Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR).
- Students must complete a minimum of 70 hours of work placement to meet the requirements of the HSC. Students who are not interested in completing work placement should not choose this course.
- Entry Requirements: Students must complete a VET Enrolment Form and supply their USI before the commencement of any training and assessment.



# Course Description

This curriculum framework course is accredited for the HSC and provides students with the opportunity to obtain nationally recognised vocational qualifications. This is known as dual accreditation. Students will be able to gain skills in planning and organising work, measuring and calculating, reading and interpreting plans, safe and environmentally sustainable work practices and the use of construction tools and equipment. Skills gained in this industry transfer to other industries. Occupations in the construction industry include: construction or trades assistant; builder's labourer; bricklayer; carpenter; plasterer; roof tiler; concreter; painter and decorator; and wall or floor tiler. Individual and group projects form part of the practical aspects of this course.
